It was the fall of 1971 in a little Assembly of God church when a 9-yearold boy named Michael, from Gerber, California, came with his family on a Sunday night.

It was a familiar place to him. Sunday School, Sunday morning, Sunday night, Wednesday night - church is where you would find him.

This particular evening though, something was different. As the service got underway, everyone stood for worship.



As the congregation began to sing, little Michael was overwhelmed by the presence of God; all he could do was weep through the entire song service. Then the pastor

came forward and began to preach; at the end of his message, he asked if anyone wanted to come forward to pray. Little Michael ran to the front and surrendered his life to Jesus Christ.

That boy was me! Jesus came into my life that night. I've never gotten over it, and I don't think you're supposed to!

This summer, we did a Power Kyd Live event in the same area. Days before the event, I got to walk the streets of town and invite kids and families to our Saturday outreach.

I knocked on a door and a young boy answered. "Hi. What's your name?" I asked. "Michael." "How old are you Michael?" "Ten." "Do you live here in Gerber?" "Yes."

"Michael, we have a lot in common: 45 years ago, I was a 10-year-old boy named Michael who lived in Gerber!" I gave Michael a flyer and invited him to the event.



When Saturday finally arrived, I was so excited to see Michael sitting in the second row. We shared the Gospel and gave an invitation to come forward to receive Christ. Children began to come forward to give their hearts to Jesus. Michael was among them and asked *Jesus into his life that day!*


